

## Enrollment Policies

The Bridge to Clemson Program has a limited number of available spaces. To reserve your space in the Bridge to Clemson Program for the 2017-2018 academic year, in lieu of the online enrollment form and non-refundable payment via credit or debit card, you may complete this form and return it with the \$750 non-refundable advance payment (check, cashier's check, money order with student name) by mail to:

Business Office, Tri-County Technical College, PO Box 587, Pendleton, SC, 29670.

Note that the form must be completed in its entirety, signed by the student, and accompanied by the nonrefundable advance payment to be processed and used to reserve your space in the Program.

- By submitting this form, you acknowledge your understanding that \$500 of the non-refundable advance payment will be applied to the Fall 2017 housing payment and the remaining \$250 will be applied to the Fall 2017 Bridge Program fees. For students who receive an approved housing waiver, the full \$750 will be applied to the Fall 2017 Bridge Program fees.
- By submitting this form, you acknowledge that there are limited spaces in the Bridge Program and understand that in the event your advance payment is received after the program is full, you will be placed on a waiting list or you will receive a full refund.
- By submitting this form, under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), you give permission to Tri-County Technical College (TCTC) and Clemson University (Clemson) to release your enrollment status, academic standing, transcript, student conduct records, and any other educational records to the other institution for the duration of your enrollment at TCTC for the purposes of administering the Bridge to Clemson Program and Clemson to release your transcript to TCTC through your second year of enrollment at Clemson for the purposes of reverse transfer. You further understand that while enrolled in the Bridge to Clemson Program, you are subject to the Student Code of Conduct of both institutions and that violations of either Code could impact your Clemson admission status.
