STUDENT SUCCESS INDICATOR DEFINITIONS

GRADUATE PLACEMENT RATE

Description

The Graduate Placement Rate reflects the success of graduates with respect to employment or continued education. Tri-County uses various methods to obtain information on graduates including: the National Student Clearinghouse; the eTRACK service of the Department of Employment and Workforce; institution-specific graduate surveys and phone calls; the Department of Defense database; social media websites (e.g., Facebook, LinkedIn); and the Banner student information system. Graduates who are deceased, disabled, or not actively seeking employment are excluded from the placement rate.

Placement Rate Formula

Number of reported graduates employed in their field of study or continuing their education full-time

Total number of graduates for the reporting year available for placement

Target Level of Achievement – Target based on State Board performance funding target 80% Graduate Placement Rate

FALL-TO-SPRING PERSISTENCE RATE

Description

The Fall-to-Spring Persistence Rate reflects the number of students from a given fall cohort who return or graduate as of the following spring. Tri-County uses data from CERS student enrollment and completions extracts reported to State Tech.

Retention Rate Formula

Total credential-seeking students from the fall term who graduated before or remained enrolled the following spring (graduated + remained enrolled)

Total credential-seeking students from the fall term

Target Level of Achievement – Target based on internal analysis and goals 85% overall fall-to-spring persistence rate

FALL-TO-FALL RETENTION RATE

Description

The Fall-to-Fall Retention Rate reflects the number of students from a given fall cohort that return, graduate, or transfer as of the following fall.

Retention Rate Formula

Total credential-seeking students from the fall term who graduated before, transferred before or remained enrolled the following fall (graduated + transferred + remained enrolled)

Total credential-seeking students from the fall term

Target Level of Achievement – Target based on internal analysis and goals 76% overall fall-to-fall retention rate

STUDENT SUCCESS RATE

Description

The Student Success Rate is a cohort based measure of graduation within 150% of normal program time, transfer-out to another postsecondary institution in South Carolina within 150% of normal time, or continuing enrollment after 150% of normal time. The cohort includes all first-time full-time freshmen enrolling in degree, diploma, or certificate programs in a given fall semester. The measure does not include high-school students enrolling in classes at the college or students enrolled in non-credit programs.

Student Success Rate Formula

Fall semester first-time full-time freshmen who graduate, transfer or remain enrolled within 150% degree time— (150% completers+150%transfers+still enrolled at the college)

Fall semester first-time full-time freshmen

Target Level of Achievement - Target based on internal analysis and goals 75% overall student success rate.

LICENSURE EXAM PASS RATES

Description

The Licensure Exam Pass Rate is cohort based measure of the number of first-time professional exams takers of those exams recognized by the Commission on Higher Education who pass a given exam on their first try divided by the total number first-time takes. The cohort includes all takers from April 1st of a given report year to March 31st of the following year. The programs that have recognized exams include: Associate Degree Nursing, Medical Laboratory Technology, Medical Assisting, Practical Nursing, Surgical Technology, and Veterinary Technology.
